



Swiss public transport stands for reliability, quality and tradition

- One in six people use public transport every day
- On average, each person travels 2,400 km by train per year, making Switzerland Europe's champion
- Almost 10 billion tonne-kilometres of freight transport by year
- ~99% punctuality – ≤6 minutes delay
- Federal government invests CHF 6 billion annually in rail infrastructure



Switzerland, the export champion

- The industry generates one-third of its revenue from exports
- 95% of Swissrail members export
- Swissrail member companies export to 106 countries worldwide.

- CHF 17.5 billion added value in Switzerland – comparable to agriculture or tourism
- Swiss public transport employs 92,600 full-time jobs = 2.3% of all jobs in Switzerland
